

**Judg. 19:3** Then her husband arose and went after her, to speak kindly to her and bring her back. He had with him his servant and a couple of donkeys. And she brought him into her father's house. And when the girl's father saw him, he came with **joy** to meet him.

**1Sam. 18:6** As they were coming home, when David returned from striking down the Philistine, <sup>g</sup>the women came out of all the cities of Israel, singing and dancing, to meet King Saul, with tambourines, with songs of **joy**, and with musical instruments. <sup>1</sup>

**1Kings 1:40** And all the people went up after him, playing on pipes, and rejoicing with great **joy**, so that the earth was split by their noise.

**1Chr. 12:40** And also their relatives, from as far as Issachar and Zebulun and Naphtali, came bringing food on donkeys and on camels and on mules and on oxen, abundant provisions of flour, <sup>c</sup>cakes of figs, clusters of raisins, and wine and oil, oxen and sheep, for there was **joy** in Israel.

**1Chr. 15:16** David also commanded the chiefs of the Levites to appoint their brothers as the singers who should play loudly on <sup>p</sup>musical instruments, on harps and lyres and cymbals, to raise sounds of **joy**.

**1Chr. 16:27** Splendor and majesty are before him;  
strength and **joy** are in his place.

**1Chr. 16:33** Then shall the trees of the forest sing for **joy**  
before the LORD, for he comes to judge the earth.

**2Chr. 20:27** Then they returned, every man of Judah and Jerusalem, and Jehoshaphat at their head, returning to Jerusalem with **joy**, <sup>s</sup>for the LORD had made them rejoice over their enemies.

**2Chr. 30:26** So there was great **joy** in Jerusalem, for <sup>j</sup>since the time of Solomon the son of David king of Israel there had been nothing like this in Jerusalem.

**Ezra 3:12** But many of the priests and Levites and heads of fathers' houses, <sup>f</sup>old men who had seen the first house, wept with a loud voice when they saw the foundation of this house being laid, though many shouted aloud for **joy**,

**Ezra 6:16** And the people of Israel, the priests and the Levites, and the rest of the returned exiles, celebrated the

<sup>i</sup>dedication of this house of God with **joy**.

**Ezra 6:22** And they kept the Feast of Unleavened Bread <sup>S</sup>seven days with **joy**, for the LORD had made them joyful <sup>t</sup>and had turned the heart of <sup>U</sup>the king of Assyria to them, so that he aided them in the work of the house of God, the God of Israel.

**Neh. 8:10** Then he said to them, “Go your way. Eat the fat and drink sweet wine and <sup>i</sup>send portions to anyone who has nothing ready, for this day is holy to our Lord. And do not be grieved, for the **joy** of the LORD is your strength.”

**Neh. 12:43** And they offered great sacrifices that day and rejoiced, for God had made them rejoice with great **joy**; the women and children also rejoiced. And the **joy** of Jerusalem was heard far away.

**Esth. 8:16** The Jews had <sup>O</sup>light and gladness and **joy** and honor. <sup>17</sup> And in every province and in every city, wherever the king’s command and his edict reached, there was gladness and **joy** among the Jews, a feast and <sup>P</sup>a holiday. <sup>Q</sup>And many from the peoples of the country declared themselves Jews, <sup>r</sup>for fear of the Jews had fallen on them.

and I caused <sup>n</sup>the widow’s heart to sing for **joy**.

**Job 33:26** then man <sup>4</sup><sup>t</sup>prays to God, and he accepts him;  
he <sup>U</sup>sees his face with a shout of **joy**,  
and he <sup>V</sup>restores to man his righteousness.

and all <sup>W</sup>the sons of God <sup>X</sup>shouted for **joy**?

**Psa. 4:7** You have put <sup>r</sup>more **joy** in my heart  
than they have when their grain and wine abound.

**Psa. 5:11** But let all who <sup>p</sup>take refuge in you <sup>q</sup>rejoice;  
let them ever sing for **joy**,  
and spread your protection over them,  
that those who love your name may <sup>r</sup>exult in you.

in your presence there is <sup>d</sup>fullness of **joy**;

**Psa. 68:3** But <sup>i</sup>the righteous shall be glad;

they shall exult before God;

they shall be jubilant with **joy!**

**Psa. 71:23** My lips will shout for **joy**,

when I sing praises to you;

my soul also, which you have <sup>n</sup>redeemed.

**Psa. 81:1** <sup>h</sup>Sing aloud to God our strength;

<sup>i</sup>shout for **joy** to the God of Jacob!

**Psa. 84:2** My soul <sup>t</sup>longs, yes, <sup>u</sup>faints

for the courts of the LORD;

my heart and flesh sing for **joy**

to <sup>V</sup>the living God.

**Psa. 92:4** For you, O LORD, have made me glad by your <sup>K</sup>work;  
at <sup>L</sup>the works of your hands I sing for **joy**.

**Psa. 96:12** let <sup>U</sup>the field exult, and everything in it!  
Then shall all <sup>V</sup>the trees of the forest sing for **joy**

**Psa. 97:11** <sup>U</sup>Light <sup>V</sup>is sown <sup>I</sup>for the righteous,  
and **joy** for the upright in heart.

**Ecc. 2:26** For to the one who pleases him <sup>i</sup>God has given wisdom and knowledge and **joy**, but to the sinner he has  
given <sup>e</sup>the business of gathering and collecting, <sup>j</sup>only to give to one who pleases God. <sup>k</sup>This also is vanity and a striving  
after wind.

**Ecc. 5:20** For he will not much remember the days of his life because God keeps him occupied with **joy** in his heart.

**Ecc. 8:15** And I commend **joy**, for man <sup>w</sup>has nothing better under the sun but to <sup>x</sup>eat and drink and be joyful, for this

**Is. 26:19** <sup>y</sup>Your dead shall live; their bodies shall rise.  
You who dwell in the dust, awake and sing for **joy**!  
For <sup>z</sup>your dew is a dew of light,  
and the earth will give birth to the dead.

**Is. 29:19** <sup>f</sup>The meek shall obtain fresh **joy** in the LORD,  
and the poor among mankind shall exult in the Holy One of Israel.

declare this <sup>f</sup>with a shout of **joy**, proclaim it,

the delight of their eyes and their soul’s desire, and also their sons and daughters,

<sup>f</sup>I will take **joy** in the God of my salvation.

**Zech. 8:19** “Thus says the LORD of hosts: The fast of the <sup>V</sup>fourth month and the fast of the <sup>W</sup>fifth and the fast of the  
<sup>X</sup>seventh and the fast of the <sup>Y</sup>tenth shall be to the house of Judah <sup>Z</sup>seasons of **joy** and gladness and cheerful feasts.  
Therefore love <sup>a</sup>truth and peace.

**Matt. 2:10** When they saw the star, they rejoiced exceedingly with great **joy**.

**Matt. 13:20** As for what was sown on rocky ground, this is the one who hears the word and immediately <sup>O</sup>receives it  
with **joy**,

**Matt. 13:44** “The kingdom of heaven <sup>X</sup>is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and covered up. Then in his  
**joy** <sup>Y</sup>he goes and sells all that he has and <sup>Z</sup>buys that field.

it <sup>O</sup>with **joy**.

**Luke 1:14** And you will have **joy** and gladness, and many will <sup>d</sup>rejoice at his birth,

**Luke 1:44** For behold, when the sound of your greeting came to my ears, the baby in my womb leaped for **joy**.

**Luke 2:10** And the angel said to them, "Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great **joy** that will be for all <sup>z</sup>the people.

**Luke 6:23** <sup>i</sup>Rejoice in that day, and leap for **joy**, for behold, your reward is great in heaven; for <sup>j</sup>so their fathers did to the prophets.

**Luke 24:41** And while they still disbelieved <sup>i</sup>for **joy** and were marveling, <sup>j</sup>he said to them, "Have you anything here to eat?"

**Luke 24:52** And they <sup>c</sup>worshiped him and <sup>z</sup>returned to Jerusalem <sup>d</sup>with great **joy**,

**John 3:29** <sup>i</sup>The one who has the bride is the bridegroom. <sup>j</sup>The friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, <sup>k</sup>rejoices greatly at the bridegroom's voice. Therefore this **joy** of mine is now complete.

**John 15:11** These things I have spoken to you, <sup>n</sup>that my **joy** may be in you, and that <sup>o</sup>your **joy** may be full.

**John 16:20** Truly, truly, I say to you, <sup>h</sup>you will weep and lament, but <sup>i</sup>the world will rejoice. You will be sorrowful, but <sup>j</sup>your sorrow will turn into **joy**. **21** <sup>k</sup>When a woman is giving birth, she has sorrow because her hour has come, but when she has delivered the baby, she no longer remembers the anguish, for **joy** that a human being has been born into the world.

**22** <sup>l</sup>So also you have sorrow now, but <sup>m</sup>I will see you again, and <sup>n</sup>your hearts will rejoice, and no one will take your **joy** from you.

**John 16:24** Until now you have asked nothing in my name. <sup>s</sup>Ask, and you will receive, <sup>t</sup>that your **joy** may be full.

**John 17:13** But now <sup>a</sup>I am coming to you, and these things I speak in the world, that they may have <sup>b</sup>my **joy** fulfilled in themselves.

**Acts 8:8** So <sup>l</sup>there was much **joy** in that city.

**Acts 12:14** Recognizing Peter's voice, <sup>a</sup>in her **joy** she did not open the gate but ran in and reported that Peter was standing at the gate.

**Acts 13:52** And the disciples were filled <sup>y</sup>with **joy** and <sup>z</sup>with the Holy Spirit.

**Acts 15:3** So, <sup>f</sup>being sent on their way by the church, they passed through both Phoenicia and Samaria, <sup>g</sup>describing in detail the conversion of the Gentiles, and <sup>h</sup>brought great **joy** to all <sup>i</sup>the brothers.<sup>1</sup>

**Rom. 14:17** <sup>h</sup>For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking but <sup>i</sup>of righteousness and <sup>j</sup>peace and **joy** in the Holy Spirit.

**Rom. 15:13** May the God of hope fill you with all <sup>l</sup>**joy** and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope.

**Rom. 15:32** so that by God's will I may come to you with **joy** and <sup>n</sup>be refreshed in your company.

And besides our own comfort, we rejoiced still more at the **joy** of Titus, because his spirit <sup>C</sup>has been refreshed by you all.

**2Cor. 8:2** for in a severe test of affliction, their abundance of **joy** and <sup>i</sup>their extreme poverty have overflowed in a wealth of generosity on their part.

**Phil. 2:2** <sup>i</sup>complete my **joy** by being <sup>j</sup>of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind.

**Phil. 2:29** So <sup>g</sup>receive him in the Lord with all **joy**, and <sup>h</sup>honor such men,

**Phil. 4:1** Therefore, my brothers, <sup>1</sup>whom I love and <sup>j</sup>long for, <sup>k</sup>my **joy** and <sup>l</sup>crown, <sup>m</sup>stand firm thus in the Lord, my beloved.

**Col. 1:11** <sup>y</sup>being strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for <sup>z</sup>all endurance and patience <sup>a</sup>with **joy**;

**1Th. 1:6** And <sup>p</sup>you became imitators of us <sup>q</sup>and of the Lord, for <sup>r</sup>you received the word in much affliction, <sup>s</sup>with the <sup>t</sup>**joy** of the Holy Spirit,

**Philem. 7** For I have derived much **joy** and <sup>k</sup>comfort from your love, my brother, because the hearts of the saints <sup>l</sup>have been refreshed through you.

**Heb. 12:2** looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, <sup>a</sup>who for the **joy** that was set before him endured the cross, despising <sup>b</sup>the shame, and <sup>c</sup>is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

**Heb. 13:17** Obey <sup>x</sup>your leaders and submit to them, <sup>y</sup>for they are keeping watch over your souls, as those who will have to <sup>z</sup>give an account. <sup>a</sup>Let them do this with **joy** and not with groaning, for that would be of no advantage to you.

**James 1:2** <sup>e</sup>Count it all **joy**, my brothers, <sup>2</sup>when you meet trials <sup>f</sup>of various kinds,

**James 4:9** <sup>k</sup>Be wretched and mourn and weep. Let your laughter be turned to mourning and your **joy** to gloom.

**1Pet. 1:8** <sup>u</sup>Though you have not seen him, you love him. <sup>v</sup>Though you do not now see him, you believe in him and rejoice with **joy** that is inexpressible and filled with glory,

**1John 1:4** And we are writing these things so <sup>k</sup>that our <sup>1</sup>**joy** may be complete.

**2John 12** <sup>t</sup>Though I have much to write to you, I would rather not use paper and ink. <sup>u</sup>Instead I hope to come to you and talk face to face, <sup>v</sup>so that our **joy** may be complete.

**3John 4** I have no greater **joy** than to hear that <sup>d</sup>my children are walking in the truth.

**Jude 24** <sup>e</sup>Now to him who is able <sup>f</sup>to keep you from stumbling and <sup>g</sup>to present you <sup>h</sup>blameless before the presence of his glory with great **joy**,
